MR. BRAD MOORE, PRESIDENT, HALLMARK HALL OF FAME PRODUCTIONS

For 26 years Brad Moore has led the Hallmark Hall of Fame, television’s most honored series of programs. In that time the Hallmark Hall of Fame has produced more than 80 movies and received 31 Emmy awards, 7 Golden Globes, and many other honors. Those films have included the single most honored program in U.S. television history and the four highest-rated movies on U.S. television during the past 20 years.

During the same period Mr. Moore has also been Hallmark’s vice-president of advertising, president of Hallmark Publishing, and a director of Crown Media Holdings, parent company of the Hallmark Channel. Prior to joining Hallmark he held positions in brand management and marketing at Procter & Gamble.

Outside of Hallmark Mr. Moore is currently chair of both the SNU Board of Trustees and the Nazarene Publishing House Board; secretary of the Nazarene Theological Seminary Board; and a member of the SNU Foundation Board, the Thought Partners advisory group to the Church of the Nazarene Board of General Superintendents, and the Production Executives Peer Group of the Academy of Television Arts & Sciences. He previously served on the boards of the Association of National Advertisers and of Kansas City public television station KCPT.

Mr. Moore earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in English from SNU in 1968. He received his Master of Business Administration from Northwestern University in 1972. Brad and his wife, Laura, his two children, Todd and Erin, and his parents and grandparents have all attended SNU. Brad and Laura hope that in the future, their grandchildren will be fifth-generation SNU students.

Today, in addition to bringing the Commencement address, Mr. Moore is receiving an honorary Doctor of Humane Letters degree from SNU for his long-time service to the Church of the Nazarene and SNU.

Ivy Ring Ceremony

Following the morning Commencement ceremony, the recessional line will follow University Marshals to Centennial Plaza in front of Webster Commons where the graduating class of 2009 will participate in one of SNU’s oldest traditions, initiated in 1933: the Ivy Ring Ceremony. Graduates are joined by holding an unbroken chain of ivy, symbolizing the unity of purpose shared by the class through their years at SNU. When the ivy is severed, graduates will be separated, signifying the parting of ways to serve God and others with the knowledge they received at SNU.

HONORS AND REGALIA

Students graduating with high cumulative grade point averages are indicated in the degree candidates list as follows. Grade point averages for the most recent semester may or may not be included.

- * **Cum laude** - cumulative GPA of 3.50 through 3.74
- ** **Magna cum laude** - cumulative GPA of 3.75 through 3.89
- *** **Summa cum laude** - cumulative GPA of 3.90 through 4.00

Hoods are unique to educational institutions and are vestments that identify the degree conferred and the granting institution. Students receiving master's degrees today are vested with a hood with the SNU colors identified in the silk lining. The edging of the hoods shows the colors of degrees conferred today: drab for Master of Business Administration, white for Master of Arts, and golden-yellow for Master of Science.

Cords and medallions worn by graduates signify membership in national honor societies and/or participation in the Ronald E. McNair Postbaccalaureate Achievement program.

White stoles indicate completion of advanced General Education coursework in SNU's Enrichment Track.

ACADEMIC MACE

The academic mace traces its origins to the medieval battle mace and royal scepter and was adopted in the 14th century as a symbol of the university's ideals and commitment to learning. On ceremonial occasions, the mace is carried by a senior faculty member at the head of the procession. At commencement exercises, the mace is placed in its stand to signal the beginning of the ceremony, and removed to mark the ceremony's end.

The SNU mace made its inaugural journey in the May 2008 Commencement. It is crafted in walnut from a tree that once grew on SNU's campus, and the stand is made from wood salvaged from another historic SNU building called The Tabernacle where early Nazarenes once worshipped. Both of these pieces of wood, though cracked and flawed, were saved by the late Dr. Lyle Tullis, SNU Professor of Sociology emeritus, whose life and service impacted countless SNU colleagues and students. His son, Dr. K. J. Tullis, used this wood to craft the mace.

Today the mace is carried by Dr. Larry Mills, Professor of Management. The honor of Mace Bearer is awarded, by a full faculty vote, to a senior member of the SNU faculty each Commencement to recognize dedicated service and outstanding character that exemplifies the SNU motto "Character/Culture/Christ." Dr. Mills has served as a faculty member at SNU since the 1969-1970 academic year.

PRESIDENT'S AWARDS

The President's Award is the highest award at SNU for traditional undergraduate students. Two students, one male and one female, are selected by a vote of the faculty and administration. Students are nominated based on academic excellence, service, campus leadership, and a demonstration of the qualities reflected in SNU's motto, "Character/Culture/Christ." The 12 finalists are noted in the list of morning degree candidates by the ^ symbol. The sculpture presented to recipients is entitled "A Cup . . . in His Name" and was crafted by SNU alumnus Scott Stearman. Their names will also be added to a plaque in Webster Commons displaying names of recipients since 1940. This marks the 70th year for presenting this award.

DISTINGUISHED ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

The Distinguished Achievement Award is an honor granted to students from each cohort in the School of Professional Studies. Selection is based on outstanding scholarship and exceptional leadership within the program and on recommendations by program directors, faculty and classmates. Recipients are identified in the list of afternoon degree candidates with the ^ symbol. This marks the 23rd year for the presentation of these awards.

HONORARY DEGREES

REV. ALEJANDRO SANDOVAL, DOCTOR OF DIVINITY

Rev. Alejandro Garza Sandoval was born in Castaños, Coahuila, Mexico, the seventh of ten children. Rev. Sandoval felt called to be a pastor at age 15 and began ministerial training at a Bible school in Monterrey at age 16. During 1970-1973, he attended Seminario Hispano Americano in San Antonio where he earned a Bachelor of Theology degree. In 1976 he earned a Master of Arts degree from SNU, and in 1982 he earned a Master of Divinity degree from Nazarene Theological Seminary.

Rev. Sandoval's ministry includes planting and pastoring six Nazarene churches, and serving as dean and instructor at the Seminario Nazareno Mexicano, coordinator for the Spanish Nazarene Churches in Dallas, and District Superintendent for Southwest Latin American District for the Church of the Nazarene. In 2004 he authored the book *Siete Declaraciones Históricas: Afirmaciones Redentoras de Jesucristo (Seven Historical Statements: Christ's Redemptive Affirmations)*.

Rev. Sandoval and his wife, Teresa, have three children, Wanda, Dan and Iris. Their 11 grandchildren are Aleyda, Anna, Oscar, Yadira, Alma, Mirella, Joy, Israel, Jorge, Katia and Rafael Alejandro.

DR. STAN TOLER, DOCTOR OF DIVINITY

Dr. Stan Toler has authored over 70 books, many of which are best sellers. Over 165 religious organizations, as well as major national and international corporations, have been enriched by his practical, inspirational and humorous presentations. Recently, movie rights for his book *The Secret Blend: A Modern Parable of Personal Success* have been sold, and a screenplay is being written. His latest book, *ReThink Your Life*, debuted at 23rd on the CBA Christian Living Best Sellers list.

Dr. Toler received a Bachelor of Theology degree in 1973 from Ohio Christian University and a Bachelor of Arts from SNU in 1988. He earned a Master of Theology degree from Florida Beacon Seminary in 1975 and a Doctor of Ministry degree from Maranatha Seminary in 1979.

Dr. Toler serves as senior pastor of Trinity Church of the Nazarene in Oklahoma City. He and his wife, Linda, have two sons, Seth and Adam, daughters-in-law, Marcy and Amanda, and one grandson, Rhett.
