As you research your options for a college education, you are attempting to find a college or university environment that will promote the development of your potential. Part of that consideration relates to campus safety. As you consider Southern Nazarene University, we want you to know some important information about personal safety and the campus environment.

Southern Nazarene University publishes a Campus Safety and Crime Report on an annual basis in compliance with the Clery Act. This report includes statistics for the previous three years concerning reported serious crimes that occurred on-campus; in certain off-campus buildings or property owned or controlled by SNU; and on public property within, or immediately adjacent to and accessible from, the campus. The report also includes institutional policies concerning campus security and tips for personal safety.

The crime statistics reported are provided by local police agencies, SNU Safety and Security and campus authorities.
