The Offices of Student Development and Housing announce plans for the upcoming academic year, 2011/2012, campus living facilities of Southern Nazarene University. These plans are a result of months of discussion and forecasting and will assist us in being good stewards of our resources as we continue to grow and improve the living-learning environment on campus.

With the A.M. Hills Residential Complex opening in January, 2011 and the continued renovations taking place in other living areas across campus, the face of Housing and Residence Life is ever changing. Additionally, the on-campus, residential community has increased from 758 students in the fall of 2009 to 799 students this past fall, 2010. All of these factors play an important role in the decision making process.

For the fall 2011 housing sign up process the following housing options will be available for students to choose: For women: Hills, Bracken, Imel, Asbury and Chapman; For Men: Snowbarger, Hills, Chapman and possibly Asbury or Imel depending upon demand. A table on the second page outlines the pricing of room and board plans for the upcoming year.

Information regarding the housing signup process will be released the week after spring break. If you have any questions before then, please contact the Office of Student Development.

This summer will be the third consecutive summer of major renovations to the campus living facilities. Last summer major renovations were done to complete the interior renovations of Bracken North and South. Additionally, updates and renovations were done on Asbury 1-3 and selected Chapman apartments received improvements. This summer Imel 1, 2, 3, & 4 will be completely renovated and updated. Asbury 4-7 will be brought up to the condition of 1-3, as well as additional work to both the interior and exterior of Chapman and exterior Bracken if time permits. Plans and research are being conducted for Chapman with the intention of conducting a complete, interior remodel to each apartment over the next 3 years.

Southern Nazarene University is a Christian, liberal arts, residential university. These three core values make SNU distinctive. This plan for the 2011/12 academic year and the summer preceding are intended to enhance the living/learning environment and overall student learning experience at SNU. - ✓ All students must live on campus unless approved by the Office of Student Development .
- ✓ All utilities including cable TV service, wireless, and wired internet services and laundry service for residents are included in these rates.
- ✓ Housing and Meal Plan contracts are year-long contracts. A fee is charged as laid out in contract terms when breaking year-long contract.
- ✓ As of 2011-2012, there are no meal plan waivers issued except for medical reasons as documented through the Disability Services Office and/or a Physician.
- ✓ Single room availability is limited. Rooms are reserved first for students with documented special needs through the Disability Services Office.
- ✓ Single Room fee is set at \$400 additional per semester from the lowest cost room offered in the designated building/living area, if space is available, regardless of reason for single room need.
- ✓ Housing and meal plans are only operational during the traditional academic year. Rates listed above are for dates of operation as listed in the Housing Contract only.
