## Why Does SNU Need a Bike Program?

- SNU does not have enough jobs on campus to meet the demand of students seeking on-campus employment.
- Therefore, if students need employment, and the finances that come as a result of working, they are forced to look off campus for employment.
- Though there are some employers within walking distance of SNU, bicycles greatly increase the number of employment opportunities for students.
- Not everyone that needs off campus employment has a vehicle on campus, nor do they have the finances to purchase a functional bicycle.

- Ride right up to your classroom building – how convenient!
- Bicycling is a great way to get some exercise and improve your health.
- Bicycling is an environmentally friendly form of transportation.
