The SNU Department of Biology offers a broad introduction to modern biology. Our courses range from the cell and molecular level, to organismal biology, human biology, and environmental studies. The curriculum offers a rigorous background in mathematics, supporting chemistry and physics, and biological studies with a number of specific focus areas available. The SNU Department of Biology has an excellent reputation for mentoring and preparing students for graduate and professional programs. Our Biology graduates understand that science is a process understood through research and posing questions to nature. They recognize that the study of natural

science is an opportunity to learn more about the author and sustainer of creation. Students are encouraged to get involved in research and practical experiences either on the SNU campus or at other collaborating locations. Students can spend a semester studying abroad at SNU's biological field station in Costa Rica, the Quetzal Education Research Center (QERC). Biology majors are typically interested in a career in the natural sciences, whether that is working with animals, humans, or the natural environment. Many biology major graduates will continue their studies in graduate school in the pursuit of highly specialized training. Other biology major graduates will pursue careers as secondary teachers, or professional training as physician's assistants.
