





## **ABOUT**

The SNU Department of Biology offers a broad introduction to modern biology. Our courses range from the cell and molecular level, to organismal biology, human biology, and environmental studies. The curriculum offers a rigorous background in mathematics, supporting chemistry and physics, and biological studies with a number of specific focus areas available. The SNU Department of Biology has an excellent reputation for mentoring and preparing students for graduate and professional programs. Our Biology graduates understand that science is a process understood through research and posing questions to nature. They recognize that the study of natural

science is an opportunity to learn more about the author and sustainer of creation. Students are encouraged to get involved in research and practical experiences either on the SNU campus or at other collaborating locations. SNU has a world class biological field station in Costa Rica, the Quetzal Education Research Center (QERC), at which students can spend a semester studying abroad.

A student in the environmental science major is typically one who is interested in studying nature and the diversity of life. Students in this major will complete courses that will have them conducting coursework outdoors (potentially including work at QERC). Environmental science graduates have gone on to graduate school, worked as park rangers, or have obtained employment with local, state and federal government agencies.
