The SNU Politics and Law program strives to equip students to be thoughtful and knowledgeable voices and actors in the political, economic and social debates of the day. It has a dedicated pre-law track for students wishing to pursue a legal career. It aims to train students to think analytically and write effectively, two skills which are essential for law school and beyond. It also has a political science track for

those looking to work in any number of related fields, businesses and policy areas.

The program offers courses in the main areas of political science – American Government, Comparative Politics, International Relations, Intro to Law – and numerous electives that examine the political context in a variety of topics, such as sports and politics, nuclear weapons, East Asian politics, Constitutional law and American foreign policy.
