POLICY: Southern Nazarene University believes that it is the responsibility

and duty for employees to exercise the privilege of voting in elections. In accordance with this philosophy, the University will grant its employees approved paid time off to vote if necessary due to work schedules and for periods of service as an election official.

PROCEDURE: All employees should be able to vote either before or after

regularly assigned work hours. However, when this is not possible

due to work schedules or location of voting, supervisors are

authorized to grant a reasonable period, up to two hours, during the work day to vote. Employees should notify their supervisor the day before an election if they will need paid time off to vote enabling the supervisor to manage schedules and ensuring proper staffing. The employee will be required to provide proof of voting

to their supervisors.
