



**UNIVERSITY REQUIRED IMMUNIZATION DOCUMENT**

Oklahoma Senate Bill 787, Title 70 3242 states, in order to enroll as a full-time or part-time student in an institution within the Oklahoma State System of Higher Education (public or private) all students shall provide written documentation of vaccinations against Hepatitis B, Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR). The bill also requires that all students who are first-time enrollees and who reside in on-campus student housing shall be vaccinated against Meningococcal disease. *If one cannot verify their immunizations, they will need to be re-immunized.* Medical, personal, moral and religious exemptions are allowed by law and such requests must be made by filling out the **Certificate of Exemption Form** found on the SNU Health Center website..

Measles, Mumps, Rubella	<b>ALL</b> new students born after 1/1/1957	Proof of vaccination with <b>TWO</b> doses of vaccine or Certificate of Exemption filed	At enrollment
Hepatitis B	<b>ALL</b> new students	Proof of vaccination with <b>THREE</b> doses of vaccine or Certificate of Exemption filed	At enrollment
Meningococcal	<b>ALL</b> students residing in on-campus housing	Proof of vaccination or Certificate of Exemption filed	At enrollment
*Tuberculosis Skin Test	<b>ALL</b> new International students	Proof of <b>NEGATIVE</b> test performed in the U.S.	At enrollment <i>*A history of BCG vaccination does not exempt you from the testing requirement.</i>

***\*ALL REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS/TESTING ARE AVAILABLE AT OKLAHOMA COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENTS.***
