



Fall 2024: 4-, 6-, & 8-Year Graduation Rates

This table contains information related to the likelihood that students who began their college career as a full-time student at SNU will complete their undergraduate degree within 4 years, 6 years, and 8 years. About half of all students complete their degree in approximately 4 years. The 8-year graduation rate is a statistic required by the US Department of Education.
